In consideration for being allowed to participate in equestrian and rodeo activities at the Parkfield Rodeo Arena and related events and activities (the "Event(s)"), I, _____, the undersigned acknowledge and agree that:

1. Rodeo is a sport that carries the inherent risk of injury and damage to my horse, my property and me. The risk of injury from the Event(s) and activities involved in this sport is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death. It is a sport that is dangerous and unpredictable. I know that horses and cattle may buck, kick, rear, bite or make sudden movements that could cause injury to the rider, competitor or any bystander. I acknowledge that the parking lot, pastures, arenas and surrounding areas may have rocks, water, holes, tree branches or other obstacles that also carry inherent risks of injury to my horse(s) and me.

2. I AM VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATING IN THE EVENT(S). I KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL RISKS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES. I assume full responsibility for my participation and inherent risks associated with horses, cattle, horseback riding, ranch rodeo events, competition and the use of these facilities and surrounding areas.

3. I agree to comply with the terms and conditions for conduct and participation as determined by Parkfield Rodeo Arena and its representatives. If I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of Parkfield Rodeo Arena representatives immediately.

4. I HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENT(S), WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless Parkfield Rodeo Arena, Kayla Santos, Sage Massey and each of their officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used for the activity ("Releasees"), from all liability to the undersigned, his or her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned arising out of or related to the Event(s), whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

5. I HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or related to my participation in the Event(s), whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

Event Rules

Match Calf Branding ~ Saturday Only ~

Enter Once. All teams run in Saturday slack, top 4 teams go against each other in Saturday Performance. If one of the top 4 teams is unable to compete in the Finals (there will be no substitute partners) and it will roll down to the next full qualified team from slack.

- Three-man team, each team member must head, heel, and work the ground.
- Legal head catch is clean around the neck or neck with one front leg. Horns, both front legs, and full figure 8 are all illegal.
- Unnecessary roughness will result in immediate disqualification.
- Ground crew must stay in designated circle until the calf is heeled.
- Ropes must be set below knee/hock and above dewclaw. Figure 8 around the hind feet must be reset
- Ropes must be removed from calf before the next one can be roped.
- Time stops when iron is in the bucket.
- Iron cannot be thrown into bucket to call for time.
- Any infractions will result in disqualification; no penalties will be given.
- Branding iron and placing of the brand will be determined before the start of the event.
- Rotation order will be announced at start of the event
- Judges decision is final.

Draw Calf Branding: ~ Sunday Only ~

Enter Once. Rodeo secretary will draw Four person teams. Each team will rope half the cattle clean around the neck or neck with one front leg then switch with ground crew. 4 minute time limit until cutoff established. Cattle must be stretched with the ropes on both front and both hind feet before brand can leave paint can. Figure 8 on hind feet must be reset. Any unnecessary roughness, including running cattle into a fence, will result in disqualification. Time stops when iron is in bucket. Iron cannot be thrown into bucket to call for time. Branding iron/placement will be determined at start of event. Draw will be posted at Rodeo grounds Friday, May 24th.

Two Man Sorting

May enter twice. Cattle will be sorted in number succession from number called by announcer. There are ten: 0-9. Any number out of order will result in a no time. 1 ½ minute time limit. This event will be held Saturday and Sunday during morning slack only.

Barrel Race

You may enter twice. Must be a different horse. Men and women can enter. All money on Pre-entered horses counts towards all-arounds. 1st division fastest time ran, 2nd division 1/2 second off, 3rd division 1 second off, 4th division 2 seconds off. Buckle awarded to fast time of the weekend.

This year the barrel race will be sanctioned by West Coast Barrel Racing Association and will count as races towards the WCBRA Finals.

\$5 WCBRA fee is included in the entry.

Late entries will be accepted day of but there will be a \$20 late fee and you must run in slack as the performance will be filled by pre-entries. ONLY two horses listed in designated entry area will be counted towards all-around. Additional horses may be added at bottom of entry (and will not count towards all-around).

Sort & Rope

Enter Once. Two person team. Time starts when team crosses a line in the middle of the arena. Team will ride to end of the arena where they will enter a small pen and bring one steer out of pen into the arena, they will head then heel steer. Gate must be shut before team can rope steer. Allowing more than one steer in the arena at any time is a disqualification. Five second penalty for one hind leg. Three legal head catches: two horns, 1/2 head or neck. Two loops. If muleys used slick neck only legal head catch.

Ladies Break-Away Roping

Enter Once. Legal head catch – Neck ONLY. A bright flag must be tied to end of rope. Roper will come from behind a barrier out of the HEELERS box. Broken barrier will be a 10 sec. penalty. Electric Eye will be used.

Amateur Team Roping

Enter twice. ACTRA #6 Team OR less. PRCA rules. Cattle chute run. Five second penalty for one hind leg. 10 second barrier. Electric eye will be used.

Open {Muley} Team Roping

Enter twice. One legal head catch: clean around the neck. Cattle chute run. Five second penalty for one hind leg. 10 second barrier. Electric eye will be used.

Ranch Team Roping

Enter Once. Team will start from behind a line at catch pen end of arena. When roper crosses line, time will start and steer will be released from roping chute. Three legal head catches: two horns, 1/2 head or neck. Time will stop when steer is headed then heeled and ropers are facing steer. One hide leg :05 second penalty. Two loops.

Steer Stopping

Enter Once. Roper will start from behind a line at catch pen end of arena. When roper crosses line, time will start and steer will be released from roping chute. Three legal head catches horns, 1/2 head, and neck. Time will stop when steer is facing horse and both are on all four feet. Jerking cattle down over backwards will be automatic disqualification. One loop.

Mixed Ribbon Roping

Enter Twice. Two-person team, one man and one woman. Either person can rope. Roper will come from behind a barrier out of the roping box. Runner must start from inside designated circle, may leave circle when chute gate opens. Steer must be standing when ribbon is taken from tail. No jerking cattle down. Runner will pull the ribbon or part of the ribbon off steers tail and return to circle for time to stop. One loop. Men and women may enter twice. No switch end entering allowed. All money counts towards all-arounds.

Cowboy Doctoring

Enter Once. Three loops. Three person teams. Contest will be run in groups. The team must head then heel a steer, put ropes on both front and both back feet then mark head with chalk. A roper may dismount to help get animal on ground but cannot tie off. All three team members must be mounted back on their own horses before flag will be dropped. 3 minute time limit.

Bronc Riding

Enter Once. PRCA Rules apply. Performances Only. Judges decision is final.

1. NO REFUNDS. ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETE AND MONEY MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES OR YOU WILL BE CHARGED A LATE FEE!! Valid veterinarian release on veterinarian stationery will be allowed in barrel racing only.

8. Rodeo arena located in downtown Parkfield. From North and South 101 take San Miguel exit into San Miguel then follow signs to Parkfield. From North and South I 5 take either 41 west or 46 west until 46 and 41 intersect. Parkfield turn off at this junction take it for 15 miles and you're there.
9. The Men's All-Around contestant must win money in two or more events. If not will go back to most money won in one event as long as they are entered in more than one event.
10. The Women's All-Around contestant must win money in two or more events. If not will go back to most money won in one event as long as they are entered in more than one event.
11. There will be Reserve All-Around Cowboy and Cowgirl Buckles Awarded.
